Hike

The Sterling Pond Trail rises 1,000 feet in elevation above the Smugglers Notch parking area. This guided 1.1 mile long trail to the top will consist of stone stairways through a beautiful forest with trickling streams. Once at the top, you will have a wonderful view of the pond and can even hike up to the top of Smugglers Notch ski area.

Given the rocky terrain, we recommend adequate hiking footwear. Expected temperatures will be in the mid-60s to low 70s. We recommend you wear clothing layers that can be removed as you climb in elevation but put back on once at the top. Temperature variations can be as much as 10 to 15 degrees from bottom to top. A water bottle is a must. If you have a small backpack, you might want to bring it.
