### **KEYNOTE SPEAKER**

#### Capt. Lee Morin, NASA Astronaut

Dr. Lee Morin was selected as an astronaut in 1996. He is one of the more famous - and certainly one of the most well-spoken - University of New Hampshire alums. The retired U.S. Navy Captain flew aboard STS-110 in 2002, which delivered the S0 (S-Zero) Truss; was the first time the station's robotic arm was used for spacewalking; and was the first time that a crew's spacewalks were based from the station's Quest Airlock. Dr. Morin performed two spacewalks during STS-110 totaling 14 hours and 9 minutes. He is currently assigned to the Exploration Branch, where he works on the Orion Multipurpose Crew Vehicle. He will enlighten us on his trips to space and his view on the future of space travel.
